PRAY FOR THE SYNOD: FOR RENEWAL IN THE DIOCESE AND UNIVERSAL CHURCH

It is always a good time to renew the life of the Church. Each of us is called to daily and ongoing renewal, and our local communities and the Universal Church is affected by this. Our own Diocese recently published its 2023-2028 Diocesan Pastoral Plan, with the intention of renewing the life of the local Church and our vigour in preaching the Gospel near and fear, inside and outside of season. Within Rockhampton, we are asking questions such as how we actively welcome those in the Church and wider community, how we foster reconciliation, how we continue to form parishioners in the faith, how we exercise a commitment to social justice, the environment, and our stewardship of particular gifts and abilities, how we continue to make our Church's safe for the young and vulnerable, how we utilise technologies, how we celebrate and how we promote the Good News we are experiencing. All of this deserves our prayer and active engagement. So too, the universal Church is challenging itself with questions like How can we be more fully a sign and instrument of union with God and of the unity of all humanity? How can a synodal Church fulfil its mission through a renewed ecumenical commitment? How can we renew and promote the Bishop's ministry from a missionary synodal perspective? And so on. Twenty questions regarding our life and witness are explored in the Instrumental Laboris document for the First Session (October 2023). You are encouraged to take both the Diocesan Pastoral Plan and the Instrumentum Laboris to your own personal prayer, and to pray for the Church in her constant effort to be renewed for the mission given her by the Lord.
