Did you know...

About Latin in the Liturgy?

Before the Second Vatican Council, the Mass was celebrated almost totally in Latin. The Council allowed the Mass to be celebrated in the vernacular (the local language of the people), so that its richness could be more fully understood and appreciated. However it was careful to point out that Latin retained a special place as the church's "sacred language" and that its use should be preserved at certain times in the liturgy:

"Steps should be taken so that the faithful may also be able to say or to sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them." (Sacrosanctum Concilium 54)

The reason for this is not to obscure the meaning of the words of the liturgy, but to give them a certain level of solemnity and sacredness. The Latin language carries with it a sense of the ancient Tradition of the church and reminds us that we are connected to the generations before us. So, just as Jewish people will pray the solemn prayers of the Passover in Hebrew, even if that is not their everyday language, so too the church invites us to preserve Latin as our sacred language in our more solemn prayers.

During Lent we will observe this principle in a small way by singing the "Lamb of God" in Latin, with the same tune as we have used in recent years.

The words are: Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccata mundi, miserere nobis.

Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccata mundi, dona nobis pacem.

The role is part-time (20 hours a week) and provides assistance to the Parish Priest in the administrative tasks of the parish.

Principal duties include:

- Providing general secretarial/administrative assistance to the Parish Priest
- Produce the weekly parish bulletin
- Maintain administrative documentation and filing systems
- Print liturgical texts and other requirements for liturgies
- Maintain rosters for Sunday Mass
- Monitor and order stock for office & church
- Maintain copyright log for hymns each week
- Maintain parish sacrament registers
- Prepare paperwork and make appointments for baptisms, marriages, and funerals
- Other general reception duties as required.

The position involves sharing of some duties with another staff member.
