About Vocations to the Priesthood

This Sunday brings National Vocations Awareness Week to a close. Today we are asked to focus in particular on the vocations to the priesthood.

We are all aware there has been a significant drop in the numbers of priests over the last twenty years or more. Another shift has been a growing sense of co-responsibility of all in the church (laity and clergy) for the Church's life and mission. This second shift has been a very positive one that reflects our church as the whole Body of Christ. But the church continues to have a great need for ordained ministry, which is part of the very essence of Jesus' intention in establishing it. The Second Vatican Council reminded us that the ordained ministry is part and parcel of the very nature of the church.

So what can we do? Well, for one thing, if you're an unmarried man you can give some serious thought to whether God is calling you to the priesthood. If you're a parent, you can make sure your sons know that priesthood is a serious possibility for them. And all of us can pray to the Lord of the Harvest for more priests for our diocese.

And please continue to pray for those currently in formation for the priesthood in our diocese: Peter Doherty (recently ordained deacon) and Grant Sutherland (in his third year at the seminary).

DIOCESAN SOCIAL JUSTIC COMMITTEE

CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING (CST) - The Principle of "Human Dignity"

This principle is the basis of all CST, and from which all human rights are derived. Our church tradition teaches that all people are "created in the image and likeness of God" and are therefore worthy of respect no matter culture, race, gender, sexuality, age or ability. Under this principle we are called to oppose racism, misogyny, unjust wars, inequality, the use of the death penalty, and to act to overcome poverty and suffering wherever we encounter it. The "Voice" referendum is an opportunity to reflect on the inequitable experiences of First Nations Peoples, and the fact that in our country, history shows that they were not always respected, and were even persecuted and killed.

Reflection/Action: (i) Get to know the history of First Nations Peoples in my local region. (ii) Read the Uluru statement "From the Heart".
