MASS TIME CHANGE

After consultation and feedback from parishioners, it seems that a majority of people would support a change of Mass time for the vigil Mass on Saturday evening at Tannum Sands and Calliope.

There was agreement also to change the Mass time at St Agnes (Agnes Water) on the fourth Sunday of the month.

Therefore, <u>beginning in January 2024</u>, these new Mass times will take effect:

- St Peter Chanel (Tannum Sands): <u>5pm</u> Saturday
 (1st, 3rd & 5th Sundays of the month)
- St Patrick's (Calliope): <u>5pm</u> Saturday (2nd and 4th Sundays of the month)
- St Agnes (Agnes Water): <u>11am</u> Sunday (4th Sunday of the month)
