ABOUT RI IN OUR LOCAL SCHOOLS?

There are many ways we can proclaim the Gospel and propagate the faith in our community. One way is *Religious Instruction* in our local state schools, and this is a missionary venture in which we can collaborate with our broader Christian family. The *Gladstone Regional Christian Leaders Network* (GRCLN) supports the carrying out of weekly Religious Instruction in our local state schools. Many children in our parish family attend these schools, and they pursue the sacraments throughout the year with the rest of our young people, such as those in our Catholic schools or who homeschool. In the state schools, students study and grow with peers who may or may not profess a Christian faith. Religious Instructors volunteer once a week to present the faith to those whose families are interested. Prior experience or the lack thereof should not be a concern, as simple, easy-to-follow resources are provided by the GRCLN, as well as support. This is an important mission for our young people, some of whom might never otherwise hear the Gospel unpacked in a structured way. RI volunteers become the face of Jesus in a very real way.

THE SIGN" ADVENT & CHRISTMAS BOOK


