Today is National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday. It is a day to give thanks to God for the wonderful contribution that Indigenous communities and individuals have made to the Australian culture in general, and to Christian communities in particular.

It's a day to ask God's continued blessings on all indigenous people, that they may continue to enrich our country by their reverence for God's creation, their rich spiritual traditions and their gifts in many areas of contemporary society, including art, music, literature, sport and more.

It's also a day to recognise the gap that still exists between indigenous and non-indigenous in the areas of health and education. As people who believe in the healing and redeeming power of Jesus Christ for all peoples, we pray for a deep reconciliation where it is needed and healing in the lives of indigenous people who are hurting.

And the Church herself in Australia will not be fully the Church that Jesus wants her to be until you have made your contribution to her life and until that contribution has been joyfully received by others."

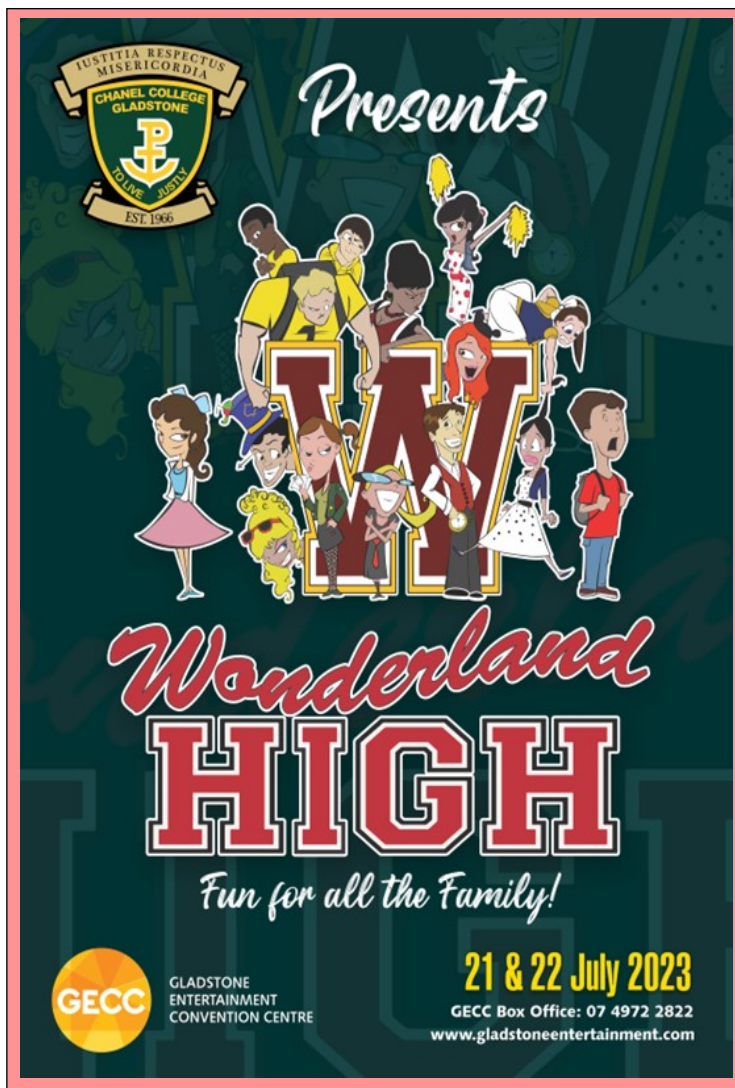

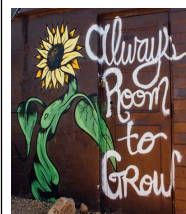
