#### ON THE WORD "SUBSTANCE" IN OUR FAITH

Our faith can be difficult to explain. It must be done with precision, otherwise we risk promoting errors. For this reason, the Church has sometimes fixed upon unique words to better describe the articles of our faith. One example is the word "substance." Where do we hear this word? Well, we recite it in our Creed each Sunday: "I believe in God, the Father almighty... [and] in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God... God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father..." We also describe the real presence of our Lord in the Eucharist using a related word, "transubstantiation."

When we use this word, we are not referring to *chemical* substances. It is a philosophical word that attempts to assert something about the *deepest reality* of a thing. It comes from the Greek word "ousia" (which means "being"), and the Latin word "substantia" (which means "something that stands under or grounds things"). When we use this word, we are looking beyond mere outward appearances. Oftentimes (not least of all in matters of faith), things are **more** than they might outwardly seem! Perhaps outward appearances alone have led us to make poor judgements, such as when we mistreat groups of people. In reality, we make a substance-claim when we say "We are human beings" – that is, we're all made of the same stuff that makes humanity human, and there is no "sub-human" person.

So, what might the word "substance" tell us about God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, and about the Bread and Wine which is raised at the altar and shared in faith, hope, and love?

#### PARISH PLANNED GIVING






The Diocesan Ministry Appeal will be conducted on the 29th and 30th of July.

Suzette has a deep admiration of the writings and life of Catherine McAuley. The Catherine 'quote' that she aspires to live by, is


