About SVDP

The Society of St Vincent de Paul was founded a mere 140 years ago in Paris, born of the compassionate heart of a young Catholic who was challenged by the words of his debating opponent. *"You are right, Ozanam, when you speak of the past! In former times Christianity worked wonders, but what is it doing for mankind now? And you, who pride yourself on your Catholicity, what are you doing now for the poor? Show us your works."* Frederick took to action.

Within a year, over a hundred joined the effort. Within a decade, the society spread throughout Italy and France, with over 9000 members. It soon reached Rome, Belgium, Ireland, the US, and by 1854 Vinnies was in Australia. Many patrons formed the Society. It is named after Fr Vincent, a saint from some centuries earlier whose love for the poor and for God's justice make him a fitting patron. Saint Louise de Marillac is another who shaped the Society's spirit by her life -long witness of care for the ill, orphaned, elderly, and those who care for them spiritually – the clergy.

These heroes responded to societal needs... which still exist today, even locally. *Poverty continues to crush the human family*. We are challenged in the same way that Frederick Ozanam once was, "*what are you doing now for the poor?*" The mission of SVDP takes a particular kind of heart – one that is humble and not condemning, that has integrity and is as selfless as it is zealous. Perhaps God is calling you to put your hand on the SVDP plough for the sake of God's little ones in this community.
