Did you know...

About Temptation?

In today's gospel reading we hear of Jesus being tempted in the wilderness by the devil. As a real human being, Jesus faced the same human struggles as we do. The Letter to the Hebrews tell us that Jesus was tempted in every way as we are, yet did not sin (Hebrews 4:15).

Temptation is something we are all faced with; the Catechism tells us that we are engaged in a battle between flesh and spirit (n. 2846), and there is a real push within us towards sinful actions. But Jesus' experience in the wilderness shows us that despite this push within us (which we call *concupiscence*), we are not powerless against it. Created in God's image we have a truly free will. And although this will has been weakened by original sin, with the help of grace we are capable of resisting sin and choosing the good.

God wants to set us free from evil and he will never try to entice us into sin. When we pray in the Lord's Prayer, "lead us not into temptation," we are making a decision of the heart to choose good over evil. We are praying for the grace not to take the path that leads to sin, and for the wisdom of the Holy Spirit to be able to discern the path of life.
