ABOUT THE 'LAST RITES'?

The Last Rites is an informal name used to describe the collection of sacramental rites that are performed by a priest with someone who is close to death. They generally include the Sacraments of Penance (Confession), Anointing of the Sick, and Viaticum (Holy Communion for the dying). There are also some special prayers of commendation for the dying person in which those gathered call on the saints for their prayers and commend the person's soul to God.

The Last Rites should not be confused with Anointing of the Sick in general. Even though they usually include this sacrament, Anointing of the Sick is not just for the dying, but for anyone who has a serious illness, frailty, or is preparing for serious surgery. The phrase 'Last Rites' should also not be confused with the word 'rights' (as in something a person is entitled to). The word 'rite' means a sacred ritual action performed by the church. In this case, they are the final sacred rituals celebrated with a person before they are called to meet the Lord.

If you know of a Catholic who is close to death and would like to receive these last rites, please don't wait until they have died, but contact the parish office to organise for a priest give them these special sacraments.
