PRAY FOR THE GIFT OF COUNSEL

The third gift is Counsel, and while today is *Pentecost Sunday* and the Church receives again her Counsellor with **all his gifts**, we will do well to continue over the coming weeks to pray explicitly for *each* of the remaining four gifts, and not simply move on as we return to Ordinary Time.

Counsel (also called *Right Judgement*) is a perfection of the natural (cardinal) virtue of prudence. What is prudence? The ability to dispose our reason to discern what is truly good in every circumstance and then to choose the right way to achieve that good. As the Proverb says, "the prudent person looks where they are going." (Prov 14 cf. CCC 1806). We can call prudence "right reason in action". So, if the virtue of prudence allows one to recognise good and ill and to choose the former while shunning the latter, the Holy Spirit's Gift of Counsel allows one to imitate the prompt, humble obedience of Jesus who is perfectly faithful to the Father, for his perfect fidelity, humility and obedience vanquishes the Enemy. We too are conquerors with the Gift of Counsel.

Come, Holy Spirit, pour on us your gift of counsel.

Help us always recognise the good you call us to,

and promptly seek it with wholehearted zeal. Amen.


We are compiling the ministries roster for the months of July to October. If you are not available anytime during this period, please contact the parish office as soon as possible.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION


