Did you know... ABOUT THE GOOD NEWS OF PURGATORY?

Purgatory is an easily misunderstood concept. Some suppose it to be *unscriptural*. This is a mistake. Is "trinity" or "incarnation" in the Scriptures? And yet we rightly believe them. Why? Because it is our Christian faith – *that is, the faith "handed on" (traditioned) by the Apostles* and their Successors. So, what's the *traditioned faith* on purgatory? Here it is, together with Scripture.

"All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but *after death they undergo purification*, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." We look to Scriptures which speak of *cleansing fire* (see Mt 12:31; Rev 21:27; 1 Cor 3:15; 1 Pet 3:19, etc.), and prayer for the dead (see 2 Macc 12:46, Lk 16:27, 1 Sam 28:15, Jer 15, 2 Tim 1:16-18, etc.). "From the beginning the Church has honoured the memory of the dead *and offered prayers* in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice..." Think of Requiem Masses offered for our deceased loved ones, not to mention every Mass which explicitly honours the dead. And we do this "so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God." (CCC 1030-32).

Purgatory is good news. We should not imagine it to be any more unpleasant than the necessary penances we already undertake. Purgatory is <u>not</u> punishment. It is more like *mission*. To be sure, our *purgation* has begun as soon as we have accepted Christ's call to take up our cross and follow him.
