PRAY FOR THE GIFT OF FORTITUDE

The fourth gift is Fortitude. By now, it has probably become clear that the Spirit's Gifts belong in a kind of exchange, as is always the case in matters of faith. God gives, and we respond in like manner; "we love because God first loved us." What is being exchanged here, then? *Fortitude for fortitude.*

Courage for courage!

We don't have to look far for hardship. Ordinary life will throw all sorts of curve balls at us. *So, we're exercising some degree of courage all the time!* This is important. Our human courage might *seem* small, but it is in fact the "rich soil" wherein God plants something truly wonderful: supernatural courage. What does *this* look like? The holy martyrs are prime examples! We sometimes marvel at their courage as if it were human, thinking "I don't have courage like that!" No. And neither did they. But God does. God takes whatever human fortitude we have been cultivating over the course of our lives, braving difficulties small and great, and in return, God imparts the Holy Spirit's Gift of Divine Fortitude — which, *unlike brash human courage*, bears the unexpected fruits of gentleness, patience, kindness, joy... in a word, fruit that will last.

**Come, Holy Spirit, pour on us your gift of fortitude.
May we always love and follow you, come what may.**

ST VINCENT PALLOTTI SCHOLARSHIP TRUST

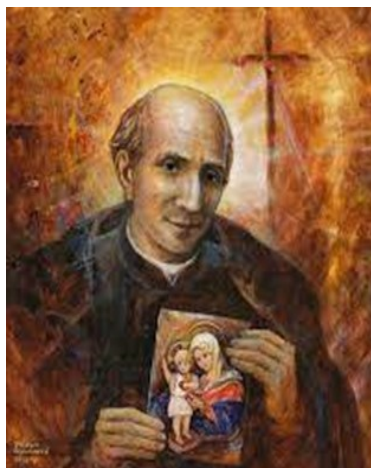

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

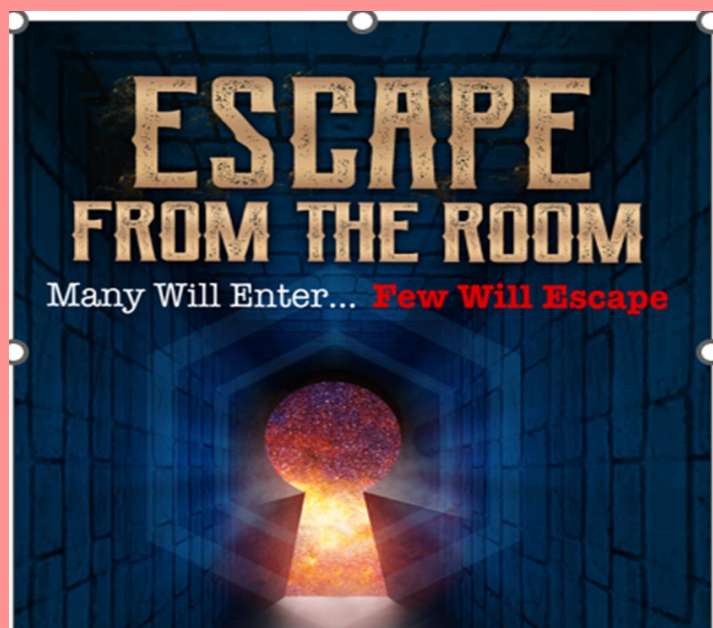
