DEVOTION TO OUR LADY

Just about every month has at least one feast for Our Lady. She is the most honoured of our saints, due to her proximity to Jesus in God's plan of salvation. She was chosen from eternity to be the mother of Our Lord and, by adoption, mother of us all. October is a month in which the Church leans into her motherhood particularly by way of the Rosary – finding therein something of the fierceness of Our Lady. As Elizabeth Johnson writes, "To be a mother is to give life abundantly out of one's own body and to nurture its wellbeing with power. Far from pusillanimity, mothering awakens fierce protective instincts as the one who gives life fights like hell to ward off what will harm the young." What is the result of this with regards to us and Mary? At worst, devotees may become frozen in the relationship of little, defenceless children forever. But *at best*, the faithful are raised into strong, healthy, mature Christian men and women - for whom Mary is not only a mother but also a sister and fellow pilgrim. We see this in the way our own family dynamics shift with time, as children grow into adults and share all the burdens of life with their elders. "Mary's mothering," Johnson continues, "has the potential to promote 'the ripeness of maturity' that enhances the dignity of all ... who [then] nurture and serve the life of others... As a popular axiom would have it, we are all meant to be mothers of God, for God is always needing to be born." Let us grow together, then, as children of the Father and of Our Lady.
