■ Did you know...

About the Mystery of the Resurrection?

Nobody saw the Resurrection happen. Numerous disciples saw the risen Jesus *afterwards*, and they saw the empty tomb. But what it looked like in the moment Jesus conquered death and rose triumphant from the grave, no human eyes saw. In the great Easter Proclamation sung at the Easter Vigil, the priest declares, "O truly blessed night, worthy alone to know the time and hour when Christ rose from the underworld."

Why did no one witness this greatest act of God? Why is it a moment witnessed only in silence by that "holy night"? Perhaps it is because the Resurrection is not just a miracle like the healing of a sick person or the parting of the Red Sea. The Resurrection is in fact an event that changed the very structure of reality itself, and perhaps this is something beyond the ability of the human mind to process.

What we celebrate today is not just a miraculous event in the life of Jesus, but the destruction of the power of death itself for all who place their hope in God. May today be a day of great joy for you and your family as we celebrate the new life of the Resurrection. Christ is Risen, Alleluia!

Saturday 22 April 4:30pm - St Patrick's Church, Calliope


