ON THE PENITENTIAL ACT

There is a certain posture from which the faithful always approach God: the posture of "sinner in need of mercy." Why is this? Understood wrongly, it may give the impression of needlessly harping on our guilt and shame and neglecting the true peace and joy of the Christian life. This is not the case.

Long before particular sinful acts, we are "sinners" in the literal sense, creatures of need. The word sin comes from the Latin sine which means "without". The fact is, God made us for relationship with himself and each other. None of us is self-sufficient. Denying our need for God and each other invariably leads to a sinful life — behaviour which is destructive and lacking in dignity and truth

Our lives should be increasingly virtuous in imitation of Jesus "the sinless one", the one who lacks nothing; "out of his fullness" all are fulfilled. The focus is Jesus, not ourselves.

Notice how all our official celebrations begin by declaring Jesus as our fullness, and us in need of him. Even after the most successful, virtuous, impressive week, we do not stroll into Mass saying, "Lord, I've done well. I deserve to be here today." Rather, even and especially as we grow in holiness, we come mindful of our own needs and the needs of the world, humbly saying, "Lord, have mercy. Christ, have mercy. Lord, have mercy."
