THE POPES NAMED LEO

Brief facts about each Pope Leo from I to XIII

We have heard a lot about our new Pope, Leo XIV. Here is a brief fact about each of the other popes named Leo. Leo I (440-461), known as St. Leo the Great, persuaded Attila the Hun to turn back from invading Rome. Leo II (682–683) improved Church music. Leo III (795–816) crowned Charlemagne as Holy Roman Emperor on Christmas Day in the year 800. Leo IV (847-855) fortified the Vatican with the Leonine Wall to protect against Saracen attacks. Leo V (903) was pope for just over one month before being deposed and imprisoned. Leo VI (928) reigned for approximately seven months during a period of unrest in Rome. Leo VII (936–939) promoted peace between local rulers and supported monastic reform. Leo VIII (963-965) was installed as pope by Emperor Otto I and is considered both a pope and an antipope because of the conflicts in Rome at the time. Leo IX (1049–1054) initiated significant Church reforms and was involved in the events leading to the East–West Schism. Leo X (1513–1521), a member of the famous Medici family, he was pope during the Renaissance, excommunicated Martin Luther, which led to the Protestant Reformation. Leo XI (1605) reigned for only 27 days, earning the nickname Papa Lampo ("Lightning Pope"). Leo XII (1823–1829) established a free clinic for the poor. Leo XIII (1878-1903) wrote Rerum Novarum, a foundational text of modern Catholic social teaching.

> This month's spiritual direction theme is Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit


We will then gather for a shared meal and fellowship in the Parish Centre from 6:20pm
