## **About the Church's Liturgical Year**

Advent marks the beginning of the Church's liturgical year and is a season of preparation leading up to Christmas. The word "Advent" comes from the Latin *ad-venire*, meaning "to come." It's a time to focus on two key events: the second coming of Christ at the end of time, and the celebration of His birth on Christmas. Rather than speculating about when Christ will return, Advent calls us to stay alert and prepare our hearts (Luke 21:34-36).

Like Lent, Advent is a time for penance and reflection, helping us prepare spiritually for the joy of Christmas. The liturgical colour for Advent is purple, symbolizing the season of preparation, except on the Third Sunday of Advent, or Gaudete Sunday, when rose may be worn.

During Advent, the Mass also reflects the season with changes like the priest wearing violet vestments and the altar being more simply decorated. From December 17 to December 24, the Church focuses on the final days of Advent, with special prayers called the "O Antiphons," which date back to at least the 8th century. These prayers draw on Old Testament imagery to proclaim Christ's coming as the fulfilment of God's promises.

One popular Advent tradition is the Advent wreath, which helps remind us of the season's meaning. To support your spiritual preparation, consider using an Advent calendar for daily prayers and activities that guide you through the season. As we await the birth of Christ, Advent is a time to quiet our hearts and as we prepare to focus on the true joy of Christmas.




# **ADVENT RESOURCE—HOPE Reigns**
