Did you know... About the Fruits of the Holy Spirit?

Next Friday and Saturday (14th & 15th June) a number of our young people will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, celebrated by Bishop Michael. As well as the seven-fold Gift of the Holy Spirit, they have learnt also about the Fruits of the Holy Spirit. The Fruits of the Spirit are the kinds of things we should expect to see in the life of someone who is filled with the Holy Spirit and living their baptismal call. The Fruits of the Spirit are the effects of God at work in us. The traditional list of nine fruits comes from St Paul's Letter to the Galatians (5:22-23):

> * Love * Joy * Peace * Patience * Kindness * Goodness * Faithfulness * Gentleness * Self-Control

The Fruits of the Holy Spirit are a kind of litmus test for our spiritual lives; they are the things to be on the look-out for. If we find them, it's a good sign we're on the right track. If they are missing, it means we need to rekindle those Gifts of the Spirit within us, by prayer and penance, the Sacraments and works of service.




