Did you know?

THERE ARE THREE GREETINGS THE PRIEST CAN USE AT THE START OF MASS

Most Catholics are familiar with the words "The Lord be with you" at the beginning of Mass—but did you know that the Church actually allows the priest three different greeting options to begin the celebration, and each are deeply scriptural?

With each greeting, the priest expresses his desire that the dynamic activity of God be given to the people of God, enabling them to do the work of transforming the world that God has entrusted to them.

The response to each of the three options is always the same: "And with your spirit".

This does not mean simply 'and also with you'. It means 'with the grace that you received through ordination for the common good; we are asking now for that grace to be made present in this celebration.'

1. "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all."

Taken from 2 Corinthians 13:13, this greeting echoes St. Paul's final blessing to the Corinthians.

2. *"Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ."* This greeting comes from the openings of several Pauline letters (Romans 1:7, 1 Corinthians 1:3).

3. *"The Lord be with you."*Perhaps the most familiar, this greeting appears repeatedly in Scripture (e.g., Ruth 2:4, Luke 1:28).
So next time you're at Mass, remember, whatever greeting is used, the response

is always the same "And with your spirit"
