Did you know

About the Torah?

Torah is the Jewish word for the first five books of what we know as the Old Testament: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy.

Collectively, these five books form the most important part of the Jewish Scriptures. The word Torah means something like, “teaching”, or “instruction”, or “law”. Jesus himself refers to it various times when he speaks of “the Law”.

The five books of the Torah represent the heart of God’s covenant, which he made with the people of Israel. It includes the story of creation and the early patriarchs of the Jewish faith, the freeing of the people of Israel from slavery in Egypt, the journey to the promised land, and the commandments of the Law which God gave the people at Mt Sinai.

The other components of the Jewish Scriptures are known collectively as “the Prophets” (*Nevi'im*) and “writings” (*Ketuvim*). While Christians group some of these books together differently from the Jewish grouping, they are essentially the same books that we have in the Old Testament.
