Did you know?

ABOUT THE 4 MARKS OF THE CHURCH?

The Nicene creed declares, "I believe in **one, holy, catholic and apostolic** church." These four adjectives are known as the four **marks** of the church; they describe something of the essential nature of what the church is:

ONE: We profess that there is only one church that Jesus Christ established (not multiple churches), and that this church is bound in a unity because of its common faith.

HOLY: This Church, despite the sins and imperfections of its members, is unfailingly holy because Jesus Christ has bound it to himself – as church we are his body. The church as a whole is holy because Jesus' Spirit dwells in it and keeps it faithful to the truth.

CATHOLIC: The Church universal: it is for all nations, races and walks of life – it excludes nobody. And it proclaims a gospel of salvation that is complete and whole.

APOSTOLIC: The Church is founded on the apostles and always looks to the testimony of the apostles as its sure link to the truth Jesus proclaimed. It also shares in the apostles' mission to spread the gospel to all the world.

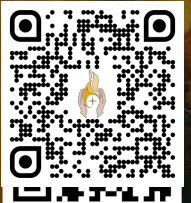
