ABOUT THE FEAST OF THE HOLY NAME OF MARY?

On Friday 12th September, we celebrated the feast day of *The Most Holy Name of Mary*, our parish's patronal feast.

There are various feast days of Mary in the Church's calendar, each of which recalls some aspect of who she is or what she has done in salvation history. The feast of The Most Holy Name of Mary aims to remind us of two things:

- 1. The special blessings and privileges bestowed on Mary by God, making her name something to be treated with love and reverence; and
- 2. Her powerful intercession for all who call on her name to pray for her help.

The choice of this feast as our special parish feast day was a logical one, given our origins and history as a parish under the care of the Marist Fathers, whose motto is *Sub Mariae Nomine* ("In Mary's Name"). In striving to "think as Mary, judge as Mary, feel and act as Mary in all things," to celebrate Mary's holy name as our parish feast day is the perfect choice.

As we celebrate this Sunday the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, we can recall just how closely Mary herself is connected to this feast: she remained with Jesus right to the end and stayed by his cross as he died. May she pray for us always!


