ABOUT THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Did you know that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick isn't just for those at the point of death? The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1499–1532) teaches that this sacrament is for anyone facing serious illness, frailty due to old age, or major surgery. Through anointing with holy oil and prayer, the priest invokes the Holy Spirit to bring strength, peace, and courage.

This sacrament unites the sick person with Christ's suffering, offering spiritual healing and, if it is God's will, even physical recovery. It also brings forgiveness of sins if the person is unable to confess. Additionally, it strengthens the person's faith in times of trial, helping them endure suffering with trust in God's plan.

More than just a personal blessing, the Anointing of the Sick is a true sacrament of the Church, instituted by Christ as a means of sanctification. Like all sacraments, it is an encounter with Christ, bringing grace that touches both body and soul. By strengthening the sick, it also fortifies the whole Church, reminding us of our call to support and pray for those who suffer. The sacrament can be repeated if a person's condition worsens or if they recover and later fall ill again. It is a powerful sign of Christ's love and mercy, bringing grace and hope to those in need.

BUILDING CONNECTIONS: PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MINISTRY NETWORKING NIGHT

On 28th February, the Pastoral Council Ministry Networking Night brought together various members of our parish for an evening of connection, sharing, and collaboration. We had 30 attendees eager to discuss what is happening in our parish and explore ways to support one another.

Each person had a chance to talk about their ministries and highlight opportunities for involvement. Many found it valuable to learn about other ministries and the people involved. There was a call for more regular events, such as shared dinners and social gatherings, to strengthen relationships before inviting others into ministry.

Some key takeaways were the need to revitalise prayer ministry, a concern for youth engagement, more social media outreach, retreats, education on liturgy and sacraments, interfaith and ecumenical dialogue, and social justice initiatives.

It was a great night of enthusiasm and commitment. The Pastoral Council will take these insights on board, aiming to create stronger connections, increase communication, and encourage participation across all areas of parish life.
