WELCOME BISHOP MICHAEL

This weekend Bishop Michael is in our parish for his annual pastoral visit. In addition to meeting with myself and Fr Peter, he has also met with our Pastoral and Finance councils and will celebrate some of our Sunday Masses.

The bishop's pastoral visit is not just something Bishop Michael does out of curiosity or as a social visit; it is actually something required by canon law. As the chief shepherd of the diocese, the bishop is "obliged to visit the diocese annually either in whole or in part so that he visits the entire diocese at least every five years..." (canon 396). The purpose of this visit is to allow the bishop to get to know the faithful entrusted to his care and to keep up to date with the pastoral activity taking place in the diocese. The *Ceremonial of Bishops* (a kind of guide book for the liturgical and pastoral duties of bishops) says that "the bishop in fulfilling the obligation to visit the parishes or local communities of his diocese should not appear to be satisfying a purely administrative duty. Rather the faithful should see in him the herald of the gospel, the teacher, shepherd and high priest of his flock."

Welcome Bishop Michael; we hope you enjoy your time with us!
