About the Centenary of Star of the Sea Church?

On the 16th November 1924, Bishop Joseph Shiel celebrated a solemn Mass and dedicated the Church of Our Lady, Star of the Sea. From that day until now – 100 years later – the Catholic people of Gladstone have faithfully gathered within these walls to give glory and honour to God and to support each other on their Christian pilgrimage.

Today we once again gather with our bishop, former pastors and religious, and the people of our parish, to give thanks to God for one hundred years of faithful worship. In the midst of our celebrations, let us remember the incredible generosity of time, talent and treasure of the people who have gone before us, who have ensured that this Church still stands today as a place of prayer and a witness to faith.

Let us remember also the countless experiences that people have had within these walls over the last hundred years: moments of joy in the baptism of a new Christian, of consolation in grief as a loved one is farewelled with the rites of Christian burial, of unearned mercy in the sacrament of Penance, of quiet closeness to God during a visit on the way home from work, of love and faithfulness in the exchange of marriage vows, and of the sublime presence of our Lord in the celebration of Eucharist.

May our beautiful Church continue as a place of faith and prayer for many years to come, and may Our Lady, Star of the Sea, continue to pray for us all.


ADVENT RESOURCE—HOPE Reigns
