### LITURGICAL SEASONS

Ordinary Time is the longest season in the Roman Catholic Church, lasting 33 weeks, and it falls outside of the major seasons of Christmas, Easter, Advent, and Lent. The term "ordinary" comes from the Latin *ordinalis*, meaning "showing order" or "sequence," as each week is numbered. This season offers a special opportunity to reflect on living as a Christian, deepen our prayer life, engage with Scripture, unite with the Lord in the Eucharist, and strive for holiness. The colour green, which symbolizes growth, is used during Ordinary Time, reflecting the Church's ongoing mission to spread the Gospel. The season concludes with the Solemnity of Christ the King.
