CANDLEMAS

Candlemas, celebrated on February 2nd, marks the presentation of Jesus in the Temple and the purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a significant event in the early life of Christ. This feast has its roots in Jewish tradition, where Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple to fulfill the law of Moses, offering a sacrifice in gratitude for the birth of their son. In the Gospel of Luke, we read about the prophet Simeon, who, upon seeing the infant Jesus, praises God, recognizing Him as the promised Savior. Simeon's words—"a light for revelation to the Gentiles" —give Candlemas its central theme: Christ as the Light of the World.

The tradition of Candlemas is deeply symbolic, inviting us to reflect on Christ's light dispelling darkness in our own lives. In many churches, candles are blessed during the Mass, reminding us of Christ's radiant presence and our call to carry that light into the world. These candles are often used throughout the year, especially for prayer and reflection, as a way of keeping that light close to us.

The candles themselves having meaning: the beeswax symbolises the pure flesh Christ received from his Virgin Mother, the wick symbolized his soul, and the flame his divinity.

As we celebrate this beautiful feast, let's take a moment to remember the ways in which Christ's light shines in our lives and how we are called to share that light with others.


