DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Sunday 27 April is Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast day was instituted by Pope St John Pau II, to draw attention to the infinite merciful love of God

shown to us in Jesus. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with the Divine Mercy prayers will be held from 3pm to 4pm at Star of

the Sea Church ending with Benediction. You are welcome to come for the whole hour or even just for part of the time.



DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

One of the popular devotions of our Church is the Divine Mercy Novena, a period of nine days of prayer leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Novena starts on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday - 27 April. There is a special intention allocated for each of the nine days of prayer:

 1st day | All Mankind especially all sinners

 2nd day | All Priests and Religious

3rd day | All Devout and Faithful Souls

4th day | All those who do not believe in God

5th day | The souls who have separated themselves from the Church

6th day | The meek and humble souls of little children

7th day | The souls who particularly venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy

8th day | The souls who are detained in purgatory9th day | The souls who have become lukewarm


NOVENA TO ST JOSEPH THE WORKER


