#### Did you know...

The Seven Spiritual Acts of Mercy, also rooted in the teachings of Jesus Christ and the early Christian community, are expressions of compassion aimed at attending to the spiritual needs of others. These acts reflect the Gospel's message of love and service extended beyond physical assistance.

- 1. Instruct the Ignorant: Share knowledge and understanding of faith and morality to those seeking guidance.
- 2. Counsel the Doubtful: Offer wisdom and support to those struggling with decisions, uncertainties, or spiritual dilemmas.
- 3. Admonish the Sinner: Lovingly correct and encourage reconciliation with those who have strayed from the path of virtue.
- 4. Bear Wrongs Patiently: Endure misunderstandings, offenses, and injustices with a spirit of forgiveness and forbearance.
- 5. Forgive Offenses Willingly: Extend mercy and reconciliation to those who have wronged us, following Christ's example of unconditional forgiveness.
- 6. Comfort the Afflicted: Offer solace, empathy, and spiritual consolation to those experiencing sorrow, grief, or hardship.
- 7. Pray for the Living and the Dead: Lift up others in prayer, interceding for their spiritual well-being and the peaceful repose of departed souls.

Just as the corporal acts of mercy address physical needs, the spiritual acts of mercy aim to nurture us spiritually, and strengthen the communal bond of love and compassion between us all, and between us and our God.

#### **Parish Administration Officer**

The role is part-time (20 hours a week) and provides assistance to the Parish Priest in the administrative tasks of the parish.

**Principal duties include:** Providing general secretarial/administrative assistance to the Parish Priest Produce the weekly parish bulletin

- Maintain administrative documentation and filing systems
- Print liturgical texts and other requirements for liturgies
- Maintain rosters for Sunday Mass
- Monitor and order stock for office & church
- Maintain copyright log for hymns each week
- Maintain parish sacrament registers
- Prepare paperwork and make appointments for baptisms, marriages, an funerals

The position involves sharing of some duties with another staff member. The position would be suitable for someone who can provide a warm and welcoming presence to parishioners and others who attend the parish office, is proficient with Microsoft Office software, and is well-organised and attentive to detail. A familiarity with the elements of parish life and practice will be a significant advantage.

The successful applicant will be provided with inhouse training and a hand-over period during which s/he will work with existing staff.




