Did you know?

ABOUT THE "O" ANTIPHONS?

The so-called "O" Antiphons are a series of seven antiphons that are used during Evening Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours during Advent. From 17th to 23rd December the focus shifts to a more immediate preparation for the celebration of Jesus' birth, and the antiphon of the Canticle of Mary (the *Magnificat*) takes the form of an acclamation addressed to Jesus. Each antiphon expresses a different aspect of how the coming of Jesus fulfils the hopes and prophecies of the Old Testament. The "O" Antiphons, in order, are:

17 Dec: "O Wisdom..."

18 Dec: "O Adonai and leader of Israel..."

19 Dec: "O Stock of Jesse..."

20 Dec: "O Key of David and Sceptre of Israel..."

21 Dec: "O Rising Sun..."

22 Dec: "O King..."

23 Dec: "O Emmanuel..."

If these antiphons sound familiar, it may be that you recognise them from the popular Advent hymn, *O Come O Come Emmanuel*, which incorporates them into its verses.
