### Did you know...

### **Ecumenism?**

Ecumenism is the work for unity among separated Christians. The Church's history contains various moments where disagreements have led to a tragic separation, and where whole groups of Christians have broken away from full unity with the Catholic Church.

Sadly, many of these disagreements have been entrenched by hardness of heart and refusal to listen to each other. Ecumenism is based on several premises:

- 1. Despite divisions, there is more that unites us than divides us;
- 2. Genuine listening to other Christians' beliefs can help to overcome false assumptions about each other;

Even when some doctrinal disagreement seems insurmountable, working and praying together is still valuable as it can build foundations for a fuller unity down the track that we can't yet see.

Catholic Magisterium is clear that work for ecumenism is not an optional extra, but a necessary part of the Church's efforts for unity. It can be as simple as praying with other non-Catholic Christians (e.g. the ecumenical prayer service last Sunday night). Or it might involve learning more about the beliefs of other Christian communities.

Ecumenism doesn't mean watering down our Catholic doctrine or pretending there are no differences. It does mean recognising the presence of God's Spirit in those communities separated from the Catholic Church and searching for ways to pray and work for the Kingdom of God together, so that Jesus' desire that all his disciples should be one may be realised.

Type of gift

STEP

Choose the type of legacy you would like to leave:

- A residuary gift: the remainder of your Estate once everything else is taken care of
- A percentage of your Estate: a specific proportion of your Estate's value.
- A specific or pecuniary gift: a specific sum of money, shares or a specific item e.g., jewellery or a painting.

Where to direct your gift

When you choose to leave a gift in your Will, you can direct it to support the Catholic Diocese of Rockhampton generally, nominate one cause or between several Catholic causes across the Diocese, such as:

- Holy Spirit Seminary
- Clergy Support Foundation
- Diocesan Ministry
- St Joseph's Cathedral Conservation
- Your home Parish


