# Did you know? =

## HALLOWEEN?

This Friday – the 31<sup>st</sup> October – is marked by some as 'Halloween'. It is largely an American observance (but like many things American it is gradually becoming more popular here too). Today the festivities of Halloween often have a rather dark focus on themes like death, ghosts, witchcraft, magic and even demons. And while many people would see it as a light-hearted and harmless occasion of fun, there is a danger associated with treating such supernatural themes so lightly; the Church has always warned of the dangers of dealing with the occult.

Yet paradoxically, this largely secular holiday has a direct link to a Christian feast – the feast of All Saints Day – which takes place on 1<sup>st</sup> November. The name itself derives from this feast day: 31<sup>st</sup> October is 'All Saints Eve' (the night before All Saints Day), which in Old English is 'All Hallows Eve', which is then abbreviated to 'Hallowe'en'. What originally was a Christian celebration of the Saints in heaven gradually became corrupted to be about the occult, magic and ghosts.

Our youth group will be celebrating All Saints Eve ("Halloween") this Friday with a Trivia and Treat night focusing on the countless saints of our church, all of whom we honour at this time.
