Did you know?

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN A POPE DIES

When a pope passes away, the Vatican follows an ancient but carefully organized procedure. First, the **Camerlengo** (a senior Vatican official) confirms the pope's death. While in the past this meant calling the pope's name three times, today doctors handle the official verification. One of the most symbolic acts that follows is the destruction of the **papal signet ring**—the ultimate sign of papal authority—to prevent any misuse

Once confirmed, the world is informed. Flags are lowered, church bells ring out, and Catholics everywhere enter a time of prayer and mourning.

A nine-day mourning period called the **Novemdiales** then begins. During this time:

- The pope's body is dressed in papal vestments.
- The body is placed in **St. Peter's Basilica** for public viewing, allowing pilgrims and world leaders to pay their respects.

Special Masses and prayers are offered across the Church.

Funerals are usually held **four to six days** after the pope's death, typically in **St. Peter's Square** with thousands gathered. The dean of the College of Cardinals leads the ceremony. Most recent popes have been laid to rest in the **Vatican Grottoes**, but Pope Francis has expressed a wish to be buried in Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome, where other popes have also been buried.

Traditionally, popes were buried in **three coffins** (cypress, zinc, and elm), but recent popes, including Francis, have chosen simpler options. A **rogito**—a document summarizing the pope's life—is placed inside the coffin.

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis.

Despite great opposition, this frail sister never failed to keep her eye on God and her heart attuned to His message for all humanity.




MERCY ASSOCIATES GATHERING

'daily business of our lives'.




BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS | EXHIBITION & RECEPTION
