ABOUT ALL SAINTS DAY?

Over the centuries the Church has recognised various individuals as outstanding in holiness, and has bestowed on them the title 'Saint', as a way of declaring definitively that these people are surely in heaven with God. However, this is not to say that *only* those Christians so recognised are saints (i.e. saved and enjoying the rewards of heaven).

This is why we have the Solemnity of All Saints, which we celebrate this Friday $(1^{st}$ November). It's a day to honour all those who have lived upright lives and are now in heaven with God, whoever they may be. It's also a day to be reminded that we are **all** called to be saints. In various places in the New Testament letters, and in other early Christian writings, the term 'saints' was used to refer to all the believers.

May this important feast inspire us to holiness, following the witness of all the Saints who have gone before us and on whose constant intercession we rely for help.
