ABOUT ST PAUL'S LIFE AFTER HIS CONVERSION?

It all began around A.D. 37, when Saul of Tarsus had a life-changing encounter with the risen Christ on the road to Damascus. That moment transformed him from a zealous persecutor of Christians into the Church's most tireless evangelist.

After his conversion, Paul didn't jump straight into preaching. He spent three years in Arabia in prayer and preparation before a brief meeting with Peter in Jerusalem. Then he returned to his hometown of Tarsus to begin quietly spreading the Gospel.

By A.D. 44, Paul had relocated to Antioch in Syria—an emerging Christian centre before heading out on his first missionary journey with Barnabas. Over the next two decades, Paul would undertake three major missionary journeys across the Roman Empire, planting churches, writing letters, and enduring incredible hardships shipwrecks, beatings, arrests, and more.

Paul spent significant time in Corinth (18 months) and Ephesus (3 years), but his travels also led him to places like Philippi, Thessalonica, Athens, and beyond. His letters to these early Christian communities now form a vital part of the New Testament.

He was arrested in Jerusalem in A.D. 58 and spent two years in prison before being sent to Rome, where he was placed under house arrest for another two years. After a brief release and possible fourth journey, Paul was imprisoned again and eventually martyred around A.D. 67 or 68 under Emperor Nero.

From persecutor to saint, Paul's journey reminds us: no one is beyond the reach of God's grace. *Fr Peter*
