#### **ABOUT THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION?**

At our recent formation sessions for ministers of Holy Communion, some people suggested that some of the input would be valuable for the whole parish. A great idea! So here is a reminder of a few of the basics of how the Church asks us to approach the reception of Holy Communion:


- Before stepping forward to receive the Host or Chalice, we make a profound bow in reverence;
- When the minister says "The Body of Christ" / "The Blood of Christ", we respond, "Amen".
- We may receive the Host either in the hand (place your hand flat and palm up) or on the tongue (extend your tongue to receive the Host);
- We must consume the Host immediately (not take it back to the pew);
- Intinction (dipping the host in the chalice) is **not** permitted;
- A person must be a Catholic who has been prepared for the sacrament, and not be conscious of any serious, unconfessed sin before receiving Holy Communion.
