Did you know?

ABOUT THE ELECTION OF A POPE?

The process for choosing a new pope is called a **conclave** (from Latin, meaning "with key", as the cardinals are 'locked in' until they have elected someone.)

The conclave begins with a special Mass *pro eligendo Papam* (for the election of a Pope) on 7th May. Cardinals of voting age (those younger than 80) assemble in the Sistine chapel for the election and until someone is successfully elected they are forbidden to have any contact with the outside world. They also make a solemn promise never to reveal anything about the voting process.

For a successful election, a person must receive two thirds of the votes, but if 30 ballots go by without a successful election, the cardinals may decide to elect someone by a simple majority of half the votes +1. After each ballot the voting papers are burned and people in St Peter's Square watch for the smoke coming from the chimney. If the ballot is unsuccessful, the smoke is black; if successful, the smoke is white.

Once someone is elected, the Dean of the College of Cardinals formally asks him if he accepts. If he answers yes, he immediately becomes Pope. The senior Cardinal Deacon then announces the news to the people in the square with the words, *habemus papam* ("we have a pope"). The new pope then emerges and gives his first papal blessing from the balcony of St Peter's Basilica.

During the coming days please pray for the cardinals to be responsive to the guidance of the Holy Spirit in electing our next pope.

BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS | EXHIBITION & RECEPTION

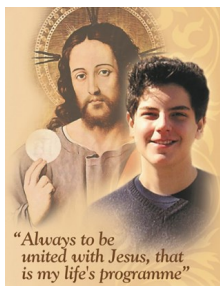
