Did you know....Fr Peter Doherty

Following on from last week's introduction to the Society of Catholic Scientists, it's helpful for us to be aware of some of the world-famous Catholic scientists today:

- Stephen M. Barr: Prof. Barr does research in theoretical particle physics, especially grand unified theories, neutrino oscillations, and particle cosmology.
- Daniel Kuebler: His research involves studying adult stem cells in bone marrow and adipose tissue for use in orthopaedic treatments.
- Karin I. Öberg: Prof. Öberg does research in astrophysics/astrochemistry, especially the impact of chemistry on planet formation, including the compositions of nascent planets.
- Maureen L. Condic: Condic's primary research focus has been the development and regeneration of the nervous system.
- Fr. Thomas Davenport, O.P: a Dominican priest, he received a bachelors degree in physics from Caltech and then his doctorate in theoretical particle physics at Stanford, writing and testing simulations for high energy particle colliders like the LHC at CERN.

Two of the most interesting Catholic scientists in history have been:

- Georges Lemaître: a Belgian priest, theoretical physicist and mathematician who proposed the Big Bang theory, which is the central pillar of modern cosmology.
- Dorothy Garrod: Disney Professor of Archaeology 1939-1952 at University of Cambridge,


