Did you know?

ABOUT THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF PAPAL DOCUMENTS?

We often hear that "the Pope has issued a document," but not all papal documents do the same thing. Some teach, govern, encourage, or make solemn announcements.

An **encyclical** is a major teaching letter from the Pope, usually on faith, morals, society, or human dignity. Pope Leo XIV's *Magnifica Humanitas*, on safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence, is a recent example.

An **apostolic exhortation** is usually pastoral and encouraging. It often follows a Synod and urges the Church to live the Gospel. Benedict XVI's *Sacramentum Caritatis*, on the Eucharist, is one example.

A **motu proprio** means "on his own initiative." It is used when the Pope makes a legal decision, changes Church discipline, or establishes structures. St John Paul II's *Misericordia Dei*, on the Sacrament of Penance, is one example.

An **apostolic constitution** is one of the most solemn papal documents, used for major legal, doctrinal, or structural matters. Benedict XVI's *Anglicanorum Coetibus*, which established Personal Ordinariates for former Anglicans entering full communion with the Catholic Church, is one example.

An **apostolic letter** is a flexible document. It may teach, encourage devotion, mark an anniversary, or make a declaration. John Paul II's *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*, on the Rosary, is one example.

A **papal bull** is an older and very formal document. Pope Francis' *Spes non confundit*, issued in 2024, proclaimed the Jubilee Year of 2025.

EUCHARIST28 UPDATE – HEARTS SET ABLAZE!

The International Eucharistic Congress in Sydney in 2028 ('Eucharist28') will be a global gathering of the Church centred on the Eucharist, the source and summit of our Christian lives, culminating in a Papal Mass with Pope Leo XIV. It will be a festival of faith, rich with worship, prayer, testimonies, art, music – a truly 'once in a lifetime' experience, and a transformative moment for our nation.

"And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they partook of food with glad and generous hearts, praising God." – Acts of the Apostles 2:46-47

The early Church was *Eucharistic*. They gathered together in community and shared in the breaking of the bread. It was through believing in and sharing in Christ's body and blood that the Holy Spirit set their hearts ablaze, strengthening them to spread the Good News without fear.

As we move forward from our celebration of Pentecost last month, our parishes and communities can imitate the early Church by devoting ourselves to the Eucharist and allowing the Holy Spirit to work within us – in our ministries, our youth groups, and our personal prayer. This national journey to Eucharist28 is an invitation for all of us to be set on fire by the Holy Spirit and share in the breaking of the bread. The journey

begins now, in our own hearts, in our own parishes.

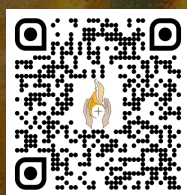
