Did you know?

ABOUT THE SOCIETY OF ST VINCENT DE PAUL?

The St Vincent de Paul Society began in Paris in 1833 when a 20-year-old university student, Frédéric Ozanam, and a few friends decided to put their Catholic faith into action. Inspired by the example of St Vincent de Paul and guided by Sister Rosalie Rendu, a Daughter of Charity who worked among the poor, they began visiting families in desperate need. Their first act of charity was simple but profound: giving their spare winter firewood to a widow.

Paris at the time was a city in crisis. Following the French Revolution, religion was on the decline, political unrest was rife, and rapid industrialisation left many without work. In 1832, a cholera epidemic killed thousands, leaving countless families destitute. When Ozanam was challenged by an opponent in a student debate to show what Christianity was doing for the poor "now," he resolved to act.

What began as a group of seven young men soon grew into parish-based "conferences" across Paris. Within a decade, the movement had spread to 48 other cities in France and Italy, with 9,000 members. The Society soon reached Rome, England, Belgium, Scotland, Ireland, the USA, and arrived in Australia in 1854.

Today, the St Vincent de Paul Society is active in **150 countries**, with **800,000** members and **1.5 million volunteers**, serving more than **30 million people every day**. From small beginnings, their mission continues to bear witness to Christ's call to serve "the least of these" with practical love and compassion.


