Did you know?

THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION?

On Monday (9th December) the church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Normally this is celebrated on the 8th December, but as this falls on a Sunday of Advent this year, the solemnity is transferred to Monday. We will celebrate Mass for this feast at 5:30pm in Star of the Sea Church.

The Immaculate Conception does *not* refer to the virgin birth of Jesus, but rather to Mary's own conception in the womb of her mother, Anne.

The dogma of the Immaculate Conception was formally defined by Pope Pius IX in 1854, but in fact it was a widespread belief for many centuries before that. The dogma of the Immaculate Conception defines the Church's belief that the virgin Mary was free from original sin from the moment of her conception. This was a unique honour given to Mary by God, in view of the salvation won for all human beings by Jesus.

Every human being is born into the world with original sin, which is washed away in baptism. Mary, because of her unique role in salvation history as the bearer of God himself in her womb, was granted the singular grace of being preserved from that original sin from the very first moment of her life.
