Did you know...

About First Reconciliation?

Enrolments are now open for our parish First Reconciliation program. This program is for any Catholic children in year 3 or older, who have not yet received the sacrament of Penance (also known as Reconciliation or Confession).

The church's practice requires people to have received this sacrament of God's forgiveness before they receive the Eucharist in Holy Communion. Our parish preparation program for Reconciliation has two components, which are designed to prepare the children to understand why we need God's forgiveness, the means Jesus has given the church to receive it, and how to prepare well to receive the grace of this sacrament.

The first component is a resource book that parents are asked to work through at home with their children over the coming weeks. The second component is the two parish workshops that children and parents attend in the leadup to receiving the sacrament.

If your child is a baptised Catholic and in year 3 or older, please contact the parish office for an enrolment form. And please pray for all the children preparing for their First Reconciliation.
