### Did you know?

### **ABOUT GOD'S WILL?**

Catholic theology makes a distinction between the *active will* and the *permissive will* of God. This is an important distinction, especially when we grapple with questions like, 'why does God allow bad things to happen in the world?'

The active will of God is what God explicitly and positively intends to happen; it includes things that necessarily take place because God wills them to (God willed to send his angel to announce the birth of the Messiah to Mary and it happened), as well as God's moral commandments (God wills that we love one another and have compassion for the needy). God's active will is always for explicit good and never for evil.

However we also speak of God's *permissive will*. This recognises that in God's infinite wisdom, God sometimes *allows* things to happen that at least seem to be evil or which cause suffering. This does not mean that God sanctions it or approves of it, but that God does not directly intervene to prevent its happening. Because God has given us free will and allows us to exercise it, he will often allow things to happen that are not part of his active will.

Ultimately, Catholic theology holds that whenever God permits something bad to happen, it is always in order that some greater good may take place. We often can't perceive what this greater good is, but in faith we know that God's wisdom is far beyond our own.
