ABOUT THE RITE OF ELECTION?

This Sunday, six of our Catechumens who are preparing for baptism at the Easter Vigil, will celebrate the Rite of Election with Bishop Michael in our cathedral.

The **Rite of Election** (also known as the **Rite of Enrolment of Names**) is one of several rituals that make up the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* (RCIA). This rite usually takes place on the First Sunday of Lent and brings to a close the extended period of catechesis known as the Catechumenate. From this point on, the catechumens who have been preparing for baptism now begin the final, more intense preparations for the sacraments of initiation. At this step the church judges their readiness for the sacraments and makes its "election" of these candidates for the sacraments. During the Mass their godparents are questioned about their readiness and the candidates themselves are asked if they wish to enter fully into the life of the Church through the sacraments of baptism, confirmation and the Eucharist. Their names are then inscribed in the Book of the Elect.

Please pray for Nicole, Sophie, Milla, Pamela, Jarrath and Mark (as well as Kennedy who is unable to attend the ceremony) as they enter the last phase of their preparation for baptism.


